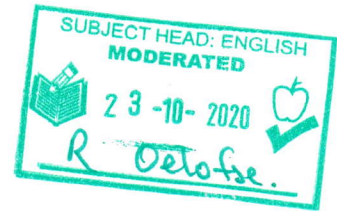

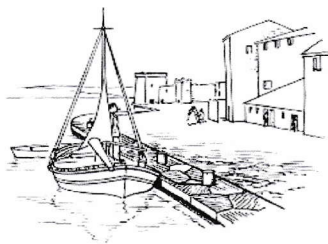
The Moon

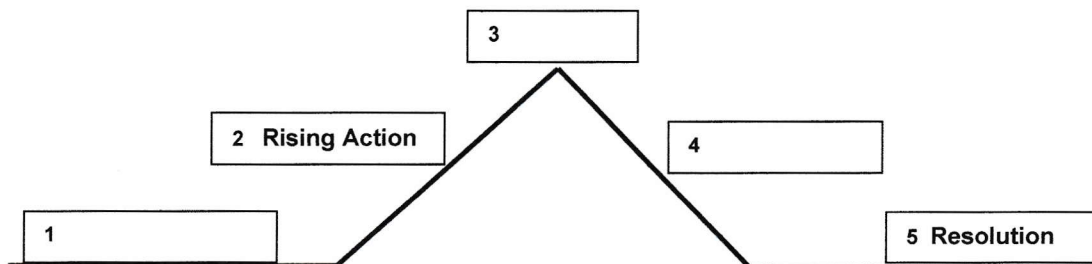

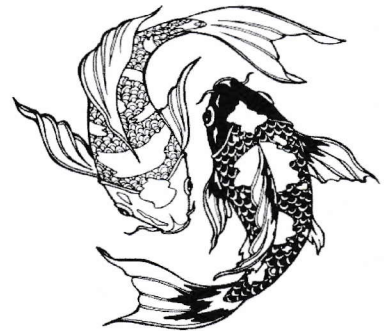
